5. Student Experience IT Request for Feedback- Cora Dupuis, Student Life (15 minutes) Question: What could the University do to improve the IT experience on campus?

• Improve the password renewal process (Votes- 40)

- Students are not always on campus to do renew their passwords, short 6 month expiry timelines/updates that can lock you out of your account. Request for easier to change password process

6. Universal Bus Pass Referendum Update (U-Pass)

Update: The Elections committee met to advertise and deliberate on Chief Returning Officer candidates. The referendum will be held October 28-30 through online voting. University of Winnipeg will vote October 27-29 and UMSU will vote October 29-31. What is being proposed is a \$260 per year (adjusted for inflation) mandatory fee. If passed by UMSU and UWSA the program would come into effect sometime between Sept 2015-Sept 2016. The results of the UMGSA referendum will identify to City of Winnipeg if we want to be included in the program or not since we were not in the original council motion. Information sessions will be held prior to the referendum date. The UMGSA will be neutral as this should be decided by students.

7. Appointment of Chief Returning Officer (CRO)

7.1. Whereas Article V Section 1 of the Elections Policy and Procedure Manual stipulates that "the CRO shall be selected by Council at the September council meeting, and will be Chair of the Elections Committee"

MOTION: BIRT the UMGSA Council vote to appoint the Elections committee nominated students at large, Karayln Dakurno (English and Film Theatre) and Joe Dipple (Native Studies) to the CRO position ending April 30, 2015.

Discussion occurred related to the process, how many candidates submitted names, recommendation considered from the last CRO report, timing and motivation of waiving the honorarium, qualifications of the candidates, amount of work, responsibility and accountability the position requires, the precedent that waiving the fee could create and the interpretation of the bylaws regarding having Co-CROs. There was a suggestion to consider reviewing or clarifying our bylaws regarding if it is acceptable to waive the honorarium. Also to determine which of our committee chairs get paid, as there is a lot of work and responsibility for the IDRC chairperson as well.

MOTION: BIRT that the two candidates receive the honorarium as stipulated in the UMGSA bylaws.
