# UMGSA Executive Reports April 1<sup>st</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019

#### **President - Carl Neumann**

#### **Executive Summary of Work:**

- April ThinkGRAD Meeting: On April 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, the April ThinkGRAD Meeting was hosted by REMDUS at the University of Sherbrooke. I attended the meeting by myself, due to uncertainty in our executive transition. The incoming VPSS would have attended with me in accordance with past practice, to gain valuable experience and meet collaborators from many other grad student groups. During the meeting, we discussed various topics relating to graduate students. These topics included the Ontario Student Choice Initiative, how to effectively engage with governments, and changes to funding for research announced in the federal budget, among many other topics. ThinkGRAD also decided to change the timing of future winter/spring meetings to January/February, rather than April, to avoid conflicts with executive transitions in particular. My year as the national Chairperson for ThinkGRAD comes to an end at the end of April, but I will be continuing as a Director-at-Large. As the only returning Director, I will guide the rest of the new Directors as they start the new executive year in May.
- Interviews for the Temporary Office Assistant: Interviews for the temporary Office Assistant were held on April 18<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. The selection committee interviewed 5 finalist candidates after having reviewed all 30 applications. We had multiple strong candidates. After deliberation, the committee selected Colin Ijebor to serve as the temporary Office Assistant during Jayne's maternity and parental leave.
- Negotiations with COPE Local 342: On April 18<sup>th</sup>, negotiations including our VP Internal were held with a negotiator sent by COPE 342, the Union representing our permanent office staff. Further tweeks and discussions took place by email thereafter. We were renegotiating the collective agreement covering our staff at the end of the regular 3 year schedule. Changes that are now approved on all sides add clarity to numerous points in the agreement, and also make the agreement consistent for all of our staff.
