## 2. Ratification of the UMGSA Council Chairperson for 2019-2020

#### 12.1. Amendments to Executive Review Committee Terms of Reference

Amendments to the structure and responsibilities of the Executive Review Committee are being proposed by the Bylaws & Policy Committee. The additions to the relevant sections of the Governance & Operations Policy Manual are included as Appendix IX to the Council meeting agenda.

**12.3. This will demonstrate our commitment to the cause, asking governments to protect our future and take emergency measures on the scale necessary to effectively fight climate change.
