## **Instructions for Submitting the Graduate Student Award Application Form**

1. Read the application instructions on page two of this document.
2. Read the terms of reference on page three of this document.
3. Go to [www.umgsa.org/student-award/](http://www.umgsa.org/student-award/) to access the application form.
4. Complete the application form electronically.
5. Submit following documents with the application:
  - I. Curriculum vitae (outlining academic, employment, and community experience) as a PDF file.
  - II. A letter (Max. 500 words) demonstrate dedication to scholarship and community involvement as a PDF file.
  - III. Most recent transcripts as a PDF File.
6. Ask your referees to fill up a referee form with letter of recommendation as a PDF file at [www.umgsa.org/student-award/](http://www.umgsa.org/student-award/). Please ensure that your referees submit their recommendations before the deadline. You need **two** letters of recommendation, as follows:
  - I. An academic letter of reference (preferably from your supervisor)
  - II. A letter of reference from a community member who can speak to your volunteering, leadership, and other non-academic commitments.

*Please note that the current UMGSA Financial Policy outlines different distributions of the UMGSA Awards. These changes have been approved by the UMGSA Council but are pending approval by the University of Manitoba Senate. We expect the new Awards distribution system to be in place for the 2019-2020 academic year.*

### **Status of your Nomination**

Your application form will be processed no later than one week after your submission, but not judged until past the deadline. Only completed applications will be considered. It is your responsibility to ensure that the Vice-President Academic receives a complete application by **Monday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 4 PM.**

The University of Manitoba Graduate Students' Association Awards Committee understands and respects the need for confidentiality in evaluation processes. Once an application has been successfully received by the Vice-President Academic, all materials contained therein will be property of the Graduate Students' Association Awards Committee until the close of the competition, after which they will be destroyed. The Chair of the Graduate Students' Association Awards Committee will notify successful candidates by email, and the student body through the UMGSA Newsletter.

## **Terms of Reference of the UMGSA Student Awards**

These Terms of Reference are based upon those approved by the University of Manitoba Senate Committee on Awards (February 27, 2013) and approved by the Senate of the University of Manitoba on April 3, 2013. As per the Terms of Reference for the Graduate Students' Association Awards:

The Graduate Students' Association confers peer-to-peer recognition of fellow graduate students who are currently not recognized by the University of Manitoba Graduate Fellowship or other national awards. The Awards are designed to recognize the important contributions of graduate students make to society through scholarship and community involvement. The awards have been made possible by the generous contribution of Dr. James Burns, a levy applied to all graduate students approved through a UMGSA referendum, and a contribution made by the Manitoba Scholarship and Bursary Initiative.

Students will submit their applications by email directly to the Vice-President Academic of the UMGSA at [vpa@umgsa.org](mailto:vpa@umgsa.org).

### **Award for Full-Time Master's Students**

Two awards valued at \$12,000 each, will be offered to students who are enrolled full-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies in a Master's program (not pre-master's), who do not already hold any major fellowships (including, but not limited to, SSHRC, NSERC, CIHR, MHRC, University of Manitoba Graduate Fellowships) and have contributed to society through scholarship and community involvement.

### **Awards for Full-Time Doctoral Students**

One award, valued at \$16,000, will be offered to a full-time student in a Doctoral program who does not hold any major fellowships (including, but not limited to, SSHRC, NSERC, CIHR, MHRC, University of Manitoba Graduate Fellowships) and has contributed to society through scholarship and community involvement. Master's students entering a Doctoral program will be eligible pending acceptance to the Doctoral program.

### **Awards for Part-Time Students**

Two awards, valued at \$5,000 each, will be offered to students enrolled part-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies in any Master's or Doctoral program who do not hold any major fellowships (including, but not limited to, SSHRC, NSERC, CIHR, MHRC, University of Manitoba Graduate Fellowships) and have contributed to society through scholarship and community involvement.

**Recipients must be registered in the academic session for which the awards are tenable in order to accept the award.** The awards will not be renewable for a second year but a recipient at the Master's level may apply and be considered again at the Ph.D. level of study. The starting date of the award is usually September. The award may be deferred for one term only (four months). Recipients will be invited to present on their academic and community contributions at the Graduate Students' Association Awards Luncheon. Due to COVID-19 health crisis, the Awards Luncheon is postponed until further notification.

Members of the UMGSA/HSGSA Executive and the UMGSA Awards Committee will not be eligible for the Graduate Students' Association Awards due to their role on the selection committee.
