1. Call to Order (5:34)

5. Committee Reports

- **5.1.** November & December Committee Reports (Appendix II)
 - i. Silvia discussed the Graduate Nursing Students' Association's request to transfer from being represented under the UMGSA, to HSGSA. A proposal was approved by the HSGSA Council. A survey/ referendum has been sent to the graduate nursing students by UMGSA office staff (currently in process).
 - ii. The UMGSA selected 300 students to receive the 2022 Holiday Hamper. Monsurul has successfully distributed around 275 of the hampers and has plans to distribute the remaining.
 - iii. During the previous UMGSA President's tenure, council approved the striking of a "Multi-Campus Committee". The purpose of the committee being for representatives from each UM campus to come together and benefit from discussions. This Committee never came to fruition. This was brought to Silvia's attention which she then decided going forward we should strike this committee.

- iv. The UMGSA Executives have been discussing an opportunity for our executives to attend a mental health workshop facilitated by David Ness with potential to become an annual program. Being an executive can be stressful at times and would be beneficial to gain tools on how to deal with it.
- v. Silvia shared that there have been concerns regarding the amount of representation HSGSA currently has in the UMGSA General Council (1 voting member). A proposal was taken to the Bylaws & Policy Committee. More updates yet to come.
- vi. Rubel discussed the manual revisions the Bylaws & Policy Committee has been working on.
- vii. The Services & Support Committee have been discussing possible surveys to be distributed in the near future including topics such as food poverty among graduate students, etc.

6. HSGSA Report

- **6.1.** November & December HSGSA Report (Appendix III)
 - i. Jamie shared that HSGSA has been working with the RFHS Dean's office for the transition of CSHRF to another University and will now host Manitoba Research Days in June 2023.
 - ii. The next major event for HSGSA is their Gala Dinner happening in March.
 - iii. The Multidisciplinary Health Research Experience (MHRE) Program has received \$2000.00 from the Science Students' Association (SSA) to help run the program.

- **7.1.** November & December Senate Reports (Appendix IV)
 - i. Uche discussed his concerns regarding food poverty among graduate students and the cost of food on campus. UMSU is also on board with this initiative as it affects their students as well. Uche spoke briefly on this topic at Orientation and a student came to him afterwards showing their concern for this issue (comparing food prices at schools back in their home countries). This issue also affects the mental health & wellbeing of our students. A survey regarding this topic will be distributed to our students shortly.
 - ii. Uche shared updates regarding the Campus Forestry Initiative. The project is currently in the stage of searching for monetary support. Uche briefly discussed the idea of commemoration trees for members of our community.
