1. President's Report

The summary of President Benarroch report is presented thus:

- The University will still maintain the mask mandate at all campuses in the Winter Term. This decision is based on the reality that COVID-19 and other respiratory infections are still of huge concern and continued to circulate in the community. For safety and health of our students and staff, and the entire university community, it is important to still maintain high level of precaution. This, however, will continue indefinitely as the University will evaluate and start gradual easing of the mandate based on scientific evidence.
- The Strategic Planning Committee engagement process has commenced. Membership of the committee included representatives from across the University community. There are various opportunities that would be available for individuals to provide input into the strategic planning process. Such information and resources to fast track the mandate would be communicated shortly. The Strategic Planning Committee will be facilitated by the Higher Education Strategy Associates (HESA). HESA has been contracted as the consultant and will be headed by Mr. Usher, Chief Executive Officer, HESA. Mr. Usher and the staff of HESA will attend the next meeting of the Strategic Planning Committee as facilitators. The consulting organization are experienced in this area as they have worked

with other Canadian postsecondary institutions to develop their strategic plans. A draft plan will be shared with the Senate Committee in May or June 2023, for discussion and feedback. The final draft to be brought to Senate and the Board of Governors in the fall, for approval.

- The President reported that a consultation session with Senators would be scheduled in February outside of the regularly scheduled February 1st Senate meeting. There would also be various other opportunities for individuals, including staff, students, and members of the external community, to participate in the process and to provide feedback, including at a Town Hall to be scheduled in late January and at consultations sessions to be carried out with each of the Faculty and School Councils. President.
- According to the President, starting from the February 1st meeting and onward, Senate meetings would be held in person. This meeting signals the first in-person since March 2020. The meeting will be held in the Senate Chamber (Room E3-262 Engineering and Information Technology Complex). A video link to Room A106 Chown Building for Senators at the Bannatyne Campus will be made available so that Senators from the Bannatyne campus can participate without having to commute to the Fort Gary campus for the in-person meeting.
- The decision to allow Senators at the Bannatyne campus to participate via a video received commendation from Professor Lavoie because it saves commute time. She suggested that this hybrid meeting arrangement should also be extended to Senators who were travelling outside of the country for research to join the meetings online. The request would be raised with the Chair of Senate and with the Senate Executive Committee.

2. Reports of other Committees of Senate, Faculty and School Councils

- a. Report of the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Graduate Studies RE: Proposal for a Master of Art in Art
- Acting Dean Main provided a reviewed proposal from the School of Art for a Master of Art in Art and Architectural History degree. The proposed program would cover Western traditions of art and architecture, as well as Indigenous, Métis, and Inuit art and

architecture. It promises to be the only Master's program in art and architectural history offered in central Canada. The program would allow Manitoba students to remain in the province to pursue their graduate studies. The curriculum would require 18 credit hours of course work, including 9 credit hours of required courses, 9 credit hours of recommended electives, a language requirement, and a thesis.

Senators were requested to review the letters of support provided by various stakeholders within and outside the province as evidence of the considerable enthusiasm for the proposal. An external review of the proposal was very positive, and the School of Art had made several adjustments in response to reviewers' recommendations based on articulation of the resources that exist within the School to offer the proposed degree.

Acting Dean Main therefore MOVED, seconded by Dean Jurkowski, THAT Senate recommended that the Board of Governors approve a proposal from the Faculty of Graduate Studies for a Master of Art in Art and Architectural History in the School of Art. The Motion was Carried by simple majority.

- 3. Reports of the Senate Committee on Instruction and Evaluation
- a. RE: Proposed Policy on Learner Immune Status

Dr. Torchia said, at its meeting on November 17, 2022, the Senate Committee on Instruction and Evaluation (SCIE) had considered a proposal from the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences to introduce the *Learner Immune Status Requirements* policy.

- i. Report of the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Graduate Studies
- Acting Dean Main informed Senators that the proposed policy had been reviewed by the Programs and Guidelines Committee and endorsed by the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Graduate Studies. The policy applies to students in pre-licensure graduate programs.

Dr. Torchia MOVED, on behalf of the Committee, THAT Senate approve the Report of the Senate Committee on Instruction and Evaluation concerning a policy on Learner Immune Status Requirements, Rady Faculty of Health Sciences, effective August 1, 2023. The Motion was carried by simple majority.
