- iii. Silvia announced that at the Board of Governors meeting yesterday, the new 2023/24 UM budget was approved. This included a tuition increase of 2.75%. UMGSA & UMSU opposed this decision. Silvia will continue the conversation with administration in hopes that this will not become an annual trend.
