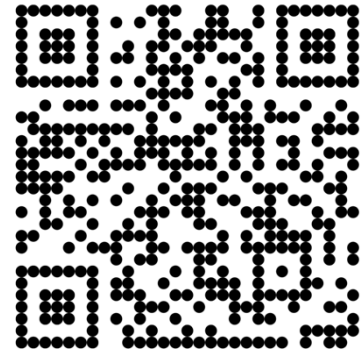
## POST-DOCTORAL TRAINING IN CLINICAL BIOCHEMISTRY UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA

Applications are now being accepted for a position in a 3-year post-doctoral training program in Clinical Biochemistry (accredited by the Canadian Academy of Clinical Biochemistry) to commence in July 2024. The program provides a unique opportunity to learn Clinical Biochemistry and gain exposure to other laboratory and clinical medicine specialties, in preparation for pursuing a career as a certified Clinical Biochemist in Canada. The program is part of the Post-Graduate Medical Education programs at the University of Manitoba. Most of the training will be provided by Shared Health Diagnostic Services, based primarily at Health Sciences Centre and St. Boniface Hospital in Winnipeg.

Candidates must have a PhD with a strong background in Biochemistry, Chemistry or related discipline. The successful candidate is a leader with proven excellent interpersonal, communication, time management and critical thinking skills. Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada.
