UMGSA Committee Reports November 1st- December 31st, 2023

Executive Committee

Chair: Christopher Yendt (UMGSA President) Meeting Dates: November 9th, November 23rd, December 7th

- We have incorporated Land Acknowledgement's and Reflections at the beginning of each meeting. We rotate speakers and invite everyone in to share perspectives and the discussion and to learn from what is shared.
- Approval of the reallocation of funds for additional Holiday Hamper disbursements, these were further approved by Council to get more money back to students as a part of our process to evaluate and execute plans to address in year savings. We have had high level conversations surrounding additional policy to make this process clearer and more transparent moving forward.
- Ongoing discussion around organizational position, risk review and decision making regarding external events and activity.
- Discussion around executive restructuring and proposed new job descriptions for staff. These remain ongoing, and we hope to post for a new position shortly and hope to access the networks of individual members of council to further promote.
- Committee discussed high level thoughts and impacts associated with the outcomes of the ERC recommendations regarding Executive performance evaluation. The team agreed to continue the conversation moving forward, and to engage in a series of one-on-one sessions with the President debriefing the review and investigating opportunities to improve these scores moving forward. Anticipating completion in January with additional outcomes provided, if any, at that time.
- The Committee discussed the existing two intake period process for onboarding new representatives onto the UMGSA Council, as outlined in the UMGSA Governance and Operations manual. High level discussion took place, and will be continued moving forward, around the ways in which we could create additional entry points and alter the process to be more reflective of the different timelines of different departments. Further considerations to be provided following the recruitment and appointment of additional staff and the successful staff transition taking place over the Winter 2024 term.
- Discussion focused on the potential impacts of a strike on behalf of Winnipeg Transit Union, and what opportunities exist for further leverage by UMGSA. The President shared that they sit on a task force the University struck to examine the issue and potential impacts. Planning and strategies were developed to deal with issues related to accessing campus but were ultimately not required as the Transit Authority and the Union reached an agreement prior to the strike deadline.
- The committee held a generative conversation on discussion topics for the team with the UM President the following week. These included issues surrounding the cost of software

for students, student employee wages, ongoing construction projects and updates on the plans of the provincial government regarding international students.

Awards and Academic Affairs Committee

- There were 342 applications for Holiday Hamper. There were 15 applications that were not in the review process because the student residency is located outside of Manitoba. The award committee reviewed 327 applications. 215 applications were selected for the hamper based on the budget (\$21,500).
- VPA notified selected students via email on 20th December that they were selected for Hamper program.
- Since the issue arose unexpectedly and was beyond our control, the process of picking up gift cards has been postponed to early January 2024. Gift cards were picked up by students between 8 and 10 January 2024.

Ad-Hoc Committee on Food Insecurity

Chair: Jamie Sookhoo Meeting Dates: November 24th, 2023, December 13th, 2023.

The FIC moved forward with the intent of creating a proposal to apply for the UofM Green Investment Fund - \$50,000 with Dr. Leslie Redmond being the faculty representative on the proposal application. The FIC's sole focus until the end of December will be to create this proposal as the deadline on December 21st, 2023. The proposal is to create a mobile application which can alert students to when there is extra food available at campus events. It was decided that if the FIC is granted this money, members will seek out students and staff who have experience and are interested in developing the app. If approved, long-term plans for the app include integration into the current UM App, integrate other on-campus food initiatives and potentially have the UM IST services take over the app. FIC members were to reach out to other universities who have already done a similar project to get information on how they did theirs so we can do ours similarly. It was decided that once the proposal is submitted, the FIC will continue to look for other avenues which we can alleviate the campus food insecurity issues among students.

The draft proposal was presented to the FIC and there was some discussion on wording. Minor improvements and improvements on tone. The proposal was then submitted on December 21st, 2023.

HSGSA Report November 1st – December 31st, 2023

HSGSA Executive Committee and Council

Chair: Akshi Malik

In November, HSGSA hosted its first multicultural event on November 25th at the Brodie Centre atrium to celebrate the cultural diversity at University of Manitoba to enrich us collectively and reaffirm our commitment to equity, inclusion, and mutual respect. The event was a super hit and over 15 students volunteered to bring food from their culture and over 50 students plus their guests attended the event.

HSGSA President also hosted the Diwali celebration for HSGSA-SBRC multicultural event series. The event was well attended by SBRC staff, faculty and students. November 15th, HSGSA executives and other student volunteers volunteered at the Rady Faculty Open House at different stations including transport, registration desk, food counter, emceed the event and Q&A.

The HSGSA Multidisciplinary Research Experience (MHRE) hosted their first meet and greet event at the fort garry campus to award the best presenters of 2023 as well as introduced the new instructors for the coming year. The event was attended by over 50 undergraduate students who are enrolled in the MHRE program. The MHRE ad-hoc committee started interviews for the graduate student instructors in November and 12 students have been selected for the program. All the selected instructors received teaching training and the lecture series have begun.

The HSGSA council approved the first HSGSA parental leave bursary application to provide support of \$1000 to a student who had to take a leave of absence in their program and does not have any other monetary support. In December, there were no executive meetings, but the HSGSA finance committee had their meeting at the end of the Fall term.

Student Senate Caucus (Dec. 5th):

• Issues regarding the volunteers needed for the committee teams were discussed.

Senate Committee on Academic Admissions (Dec. 14th):

- Integrity issues regarding the AI-based content which are used by the students were discussed.
- Launching structured and clear rules for students to make sure they are not violating the Integrity unknowingly was discussed.

Meeting with Michael Benarroch, Laurie Schnarr, and Kelley Main (Dec. 12th)

- I followed up with Dr. Benarroch for the Health Insurance coverage for students. Because of the previous effort by the team, this plan is now on the new government to-do list, Dr. Benarroch agreed to follow that up as well to hopefully have it for the new academic year. We are also trying to set an appointment with the education minister to put it on the high-priority jobs.
- Dr. Benarroch talked about the plans for extending the residences for staff and students which also Include daycare, clinic, etc.
- I brought up the challenge that international students are going to have with the new financial requirements defined for the financial proof. From the new admission year, the students are no longer able to put their scholarship letter as the financial support of their visa application as it is not enough for that. Dr. Benarroch mentioned that this is mainly for short-term students. He also mentioned that they will discuss that and find a solution by the new admission year.

Graduate Students Experience Committee (Dec. 15th):

- Dr. Kelly Main discussed the courses that are going to be removed from the College of Nursing.
- Students' reps discussed the challenges students already face including economic and residential issues.
- I proposed a plan to ask all Graduate Students Advisors (GSA) administrators of departments to inform their students regarding the Students Association activities. We are still seeing that the student associations dynamic has not returned to the before Covid status.
